If the answer is YES, you should apply for the 2020-2021 NTP-STAG Canada RV Technician Bursary!

RVDA of Canada will award one top bursary of \$1,500 and seven additional bursaries valued at \$1,000 each to eligible RV technicians in all Canadian Provinces and Territories, who have successfully completed an RV apprenticeship or related educational programs.

CRITERIA

All training courses must be completed between August 1, 2020 and May 31, 2021 in order to be considered for a bursary.

All technicians employed at an RVDA of Canada member location are eligible to apply.

Bursaries will be awarded to the technician with serious interest and desire to succeed in the RV industry as demonstrated by successful program completion*.

*Successfully pass each course with a minimum of 70% or higher in the final grade, or as determined by the course specifications.

Application closes on June 1, 2021.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

This bursary is applicable only to the programs listed under "eligible programs."

1. Completed application form
2. Employer reference letter or video critique
3. Complete one of three options:
 - A video (minimum one minute)
 - A photo compilation
 - An essay (minimum 600 words)
4. A copy of course transcript clearly showing successful course completion between August 1, 2020 and May 31, 2021.

1. Clearly outline the issue
2. Lay out the steps taken to troubleshoot
3. Perform the necessary, step by step repair
4. Supervisor critique of the task



Submit an essay

Describe an aspect of the trade that you're deeply passionate about or the most complicated task you have ever dealt with, in 600 words or more.

Supervisor to outline the reason(s) you are a strong contender for this bursary in written or video format.



Review your application

- 1 Completed application form
- 2 Photo slides, video or essay
- 3 Copy of course transcript clearly showing passing grade
- 4 Employer critique in written or video format
