Bursaries will be awarded to the RV dealership personnel working in a fixed operations capacity with a serious interest and desire to succeed in the RV industry as demonstrated by successful program completion*.

*Successfully pass each course with a minimum of 70% or higher in the final grade, or as determined by the course specifications.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

This bursary is applicable only to the programs listed under "eligible programs."

1. Completed application form
2. Employer reference letter or video critique
3. Complete one of two options:
 - A video (minimum one minute)
 - An essay (minimum 600 words)
4. A copy of course transcript clearly showing successful course completion between August 1, 2021 and May 31, 2022.
